<p>Literacy</p>		<p>Non-fiction – Owl Babies Fiction – Big Book of Families</p> <p>Non-Fiction – The Three Little Pigs The Gingerbread Man Dear Santa</p>
<p>Mathematics</p>		<p>Build on previous experiences of number from their home and nursery environments. To count accurately. Hear and join in with the counting sequences. Explore the composition of numbers within 5 e.g. 3+1=4. Begin to compare sets of objects and use the language of comparison. Continue and recreate patterns.</p>
<p>Understanding the World: Science</p>		<p>Oral Health – Why and how do we brush our teeth. Autumn season – Observe signs of Autumn. Name different materials and explore their properties.</p>
<p>Understanding the World: Geography</p>		<p>Identify where we live. Discuss key buildings around our local area. Visit a Church.</p>
<p>Understanding the World: History</p>		<p>All about me – How have I changed? Create a timeline e.g. baby, toddler and child. Remembrance Day – What is it?</p>
<p>Physical Development: PE</p>		<p>Fundamental Skills – Nursery Rhymes. Fundamental Skills – Jack and the Beanstalk.</p>
